- Be familiar with the contracted scope of work and allocated hours for the assigned tasks.
- Maintain a professional level of courtesy while working on many different projects. Open to regular and constructive feedback.
- Self-driven: Able to balance competing project priorities, deadlines and respond quickly to client demands.
